The Silent Power Released in Adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament



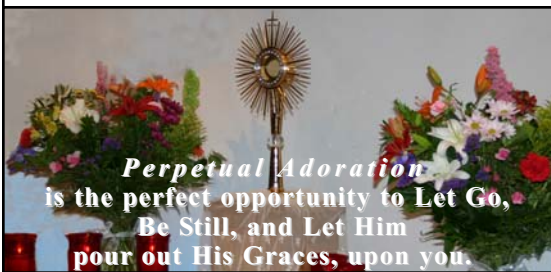

"There have been numerous miracles attributed to Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration, including the return of adult children to the Church, alcoholic sons and husbands joining AA and coming back to the Church, husbands and wives reconciled and non-Catholic spouses joining the Church.

Also there have been phenomenal physical healings, including one man who had been in an extended coma who was totally cured after the prayer of his small son, before the Blessed Sacrament.

One of the greatest ongoing miracles is the total lack of vandalism and crime since starting Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration. Our Parish is in the immediate vicinity of what you might call skid row, with the homeless shelter and rescue mission nearby. There have been no assaults, robberies or gang activity. It's like the Lord has placed a protective dome over the Church grounds.

Another miracle that I have witnessed, is the extraordinary cooperation and absence of jealousy between the different groups within the Church. They



have learned that by making our Eucharistic Lord the center of all activity, their individual interests are blessed beyond their expectations..."
